In view of the Covid-19 Pandemic, the National guidelines for admission to treatment facilities have been changed.

At Jullo, we value your health and the health of our staff. Our facility has been reconfigured for compliance. Social Distancing and Hand Washing plus Masking is essential. Our Covid-19 disclosure and Consent form is now required on admission.

Jullo reserves the following rights.

A negative Covid-19 test for the 5 days prior to admission. Request forms can be made available by calling Jullo on 0861114870 for a telemedicine consultation or from your healthcare provider. See telemedicine guidelines.

To detoxify or admit to our Infection Control Ward before integration.

Smoking prohibited during isolation period. Patient may bring in Nicorette or Champix or funds for these aids. Smoking in designated areas are allowed on reintegration.

Patients and luggage decontamination and further screening and testing if clinically indicated.

Daily clinical monitoring.

No visitation allowed. To prevent contamination, Laundry services will be available at additional cost.

COVID-19 PANDEMIC – DISCLOSURE AND CONSENT FORM

I \_\_\_\_\_, knowingly and willingly

consent for myself or for a minor \_\_\_\_\_,

under my care to have urgent elective or emergency medical treatment during the COVID-19 pandemic.

I understand that:

- People can catch COVID-19 from others who have the virus.
- The disease can spread from person to person through small droplets from the nose or mouth which are spread when a person with COVID-19 coughs or exhales.
- These droplets land on objects and surfaces around the person.
- Other people then catch COVID-19 by touching these objects or surfaces, then touching their eyes, nose or mouth.
- People can also catch COVID-19 if they breathe in droplets from a person with COVID-19 who coughs out or exhales droplets.
- This is why it is important to stay more than 2 meter away, especially from a person who is sick.
- The COVID-19 virus has a long incubation period during which carriers of the virus might not show symptoms and still be highly contagious.
- It is impossible to determine per patient/person.

Medical procedures may take place with the patient in close proximity to the medical practitioner. This potentially exposes the patient and the medical practitioner to respiratory droplets which may spread the disease.

- I understand that due to the frequency of visits of other patients, the characteristics of the virus, and the nature of consultations and medical procedures, that I have an elevated risk of obtaining the virus simply by being in a medical practice. \_\_\_\_\_ **(Initial)**
